



## Student Right-to-Know Act Graduation Rate Report

Per the Student Right-to-Know and Campus Security Act of 1990, the College of Coastal Georgia would like to share the graduation rates of the Fall 2013 cohort of first-time, full-time, baccalaureate degree-seeking undergraduate students.

As reported in the IPEDS graduation rates survey (GRS), during the Fall 2013 semester, 241 first-time, full-time, baccalaureate degree-seeking undergraduate students entered Coastal Georgia. Twenty-seven percent of these students had graduated from Coastal Georgia within 150% of the normal time to complete their degree (as of August 31, 2019). For example, for a four-year degree program, entering students who complete within six years are counted as graduates.
