

## 2. Lily Heidger, Vice President

- a) Senate Meeting Report-
  - (1) Transparency- sending out a weekly newsletter including anything that has happened around campus in the student body and SGA.
  - (2) Tabling- Successful! There have been a bunch of great pictures and many people have signed. How to get professors and other staff to enforce.
  - (3) Library Hours- a meeting has been set up to discuss extending library hours.
  - (4) Dining - repetitive and very little options. The salad bar has also not been available on the weekends. Have a meeting with some staff from the dining hall.
  - (5) The BRIG and fitness center- has not been open when it was supposed to be open.
  - (6) Safety on campus- There have been groups of people standing outside and waiting for other people to come in. Erin has spoken to them, but it hasn't been monitored. There have been incidents of people following students. People have reached out to the police and there has been no action
- b) What can SGA be doing now?

- 1) Library Hours- Have meeting and discuss further action to broaden the hours
- 2) Dining- Have a meeting with some Dining Hall staff
- 3) Safety of Campus- we should involve the police in the conversation. They could give some tips and tricks on how to handle the situation. A Lot of these incidents have been in the evening, and with the same groups of people. The desks are open until 10:00pm. The RA on call should be getting called, and the phone numbers should be more readily available and posted somewhere online. Next step would be to have a meeting on how to make information more available.
